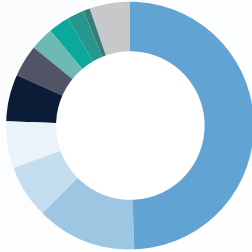

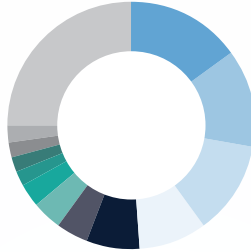


Open Source Summit & Embedded Linux Conference Europe 2019 Demographics



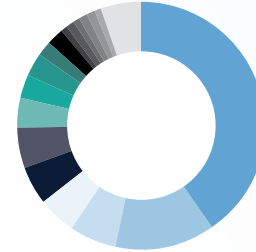

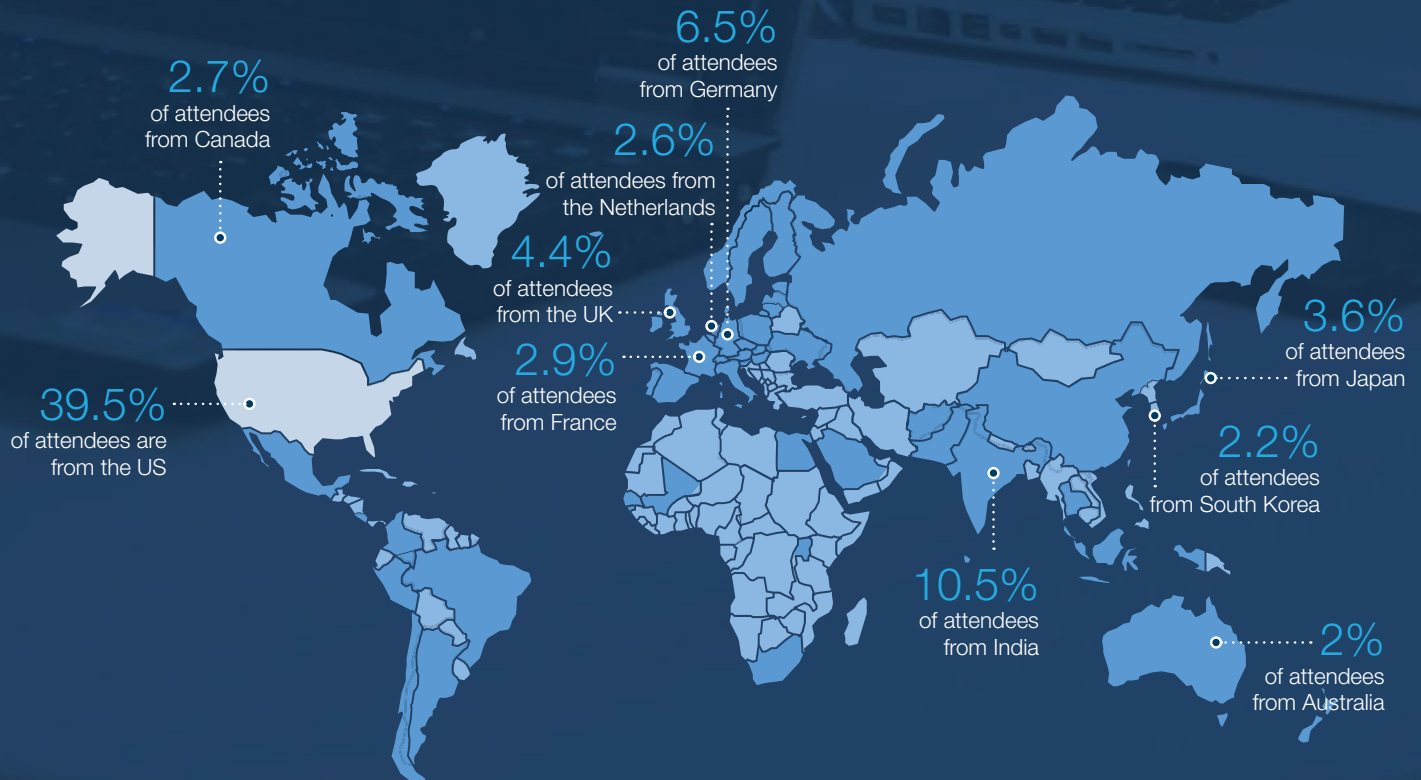

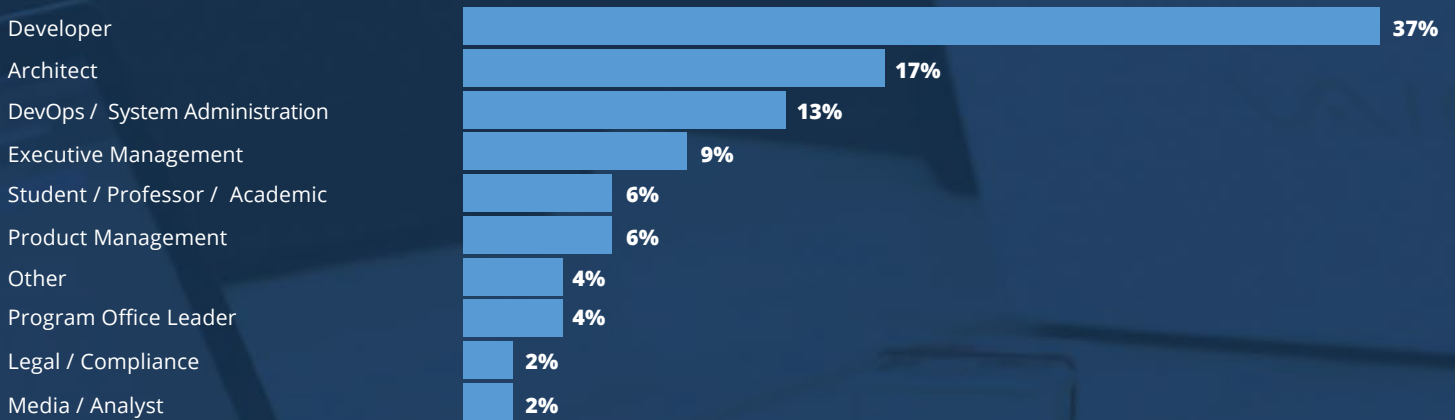

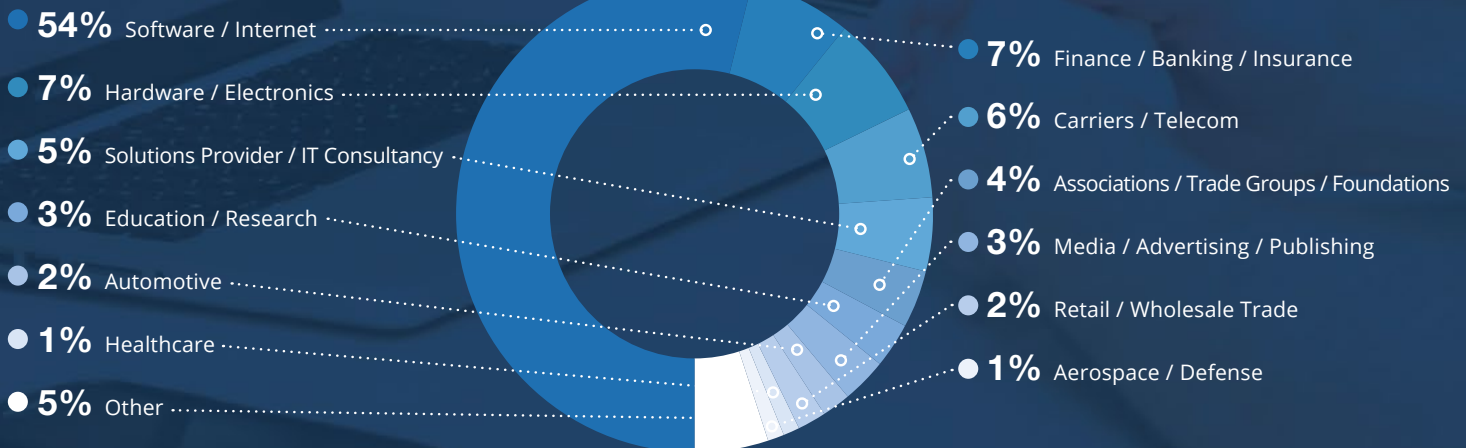
