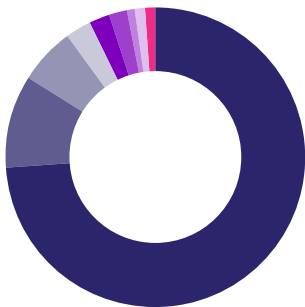

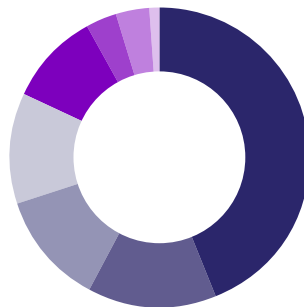

WasmCon 2023 Attendee Demographics



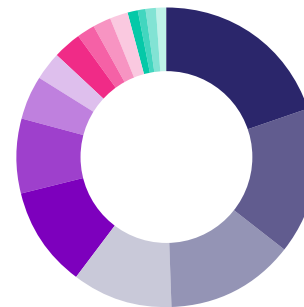
