The API Specifications Conference (ASC) is a place for API practitioners to come together and discuss the evolution of API technology. In its second year, ASC includes cutting edge technology keynotes and sessions that chart the future of APIs, in-depth specification and standards discussions and an extensive tutorial track. From the United States, 66% were from the West, South 19%, Northeast 10%, and Midwest 5%




