## Attendee Guide

### GET STARTED

- All event participants must abide by our [Code of Conduct](#).
- The event opens to attendees starting on Sunday, August 16 at 16:00 CEST. Take advantage of this **early access** to become familiar with the platform, update your profile, and set your time zone.
- The event is held on Central European Summer Time (CEST) and all times listed in the platform and on [Sched](#) will default to CEST.

### ACCESS THE EVENT

- You must be **registered** to attend KubeCon + CloudNativeCon Europe 2020 Virtual.
- You will need your **confirmation number** (found in your registration confirmation email) and the **same email address** you used to register for the event.
- If you're viewing the event on a screen smaller than 15 inches, we recommend that you zoom out manually.
- **Run a system check** to ensure your computer is configured properly for the virtual event platform.
- **Run a compatibility check**, which tests your webcam and audio devices.

### TECH SUPPORT

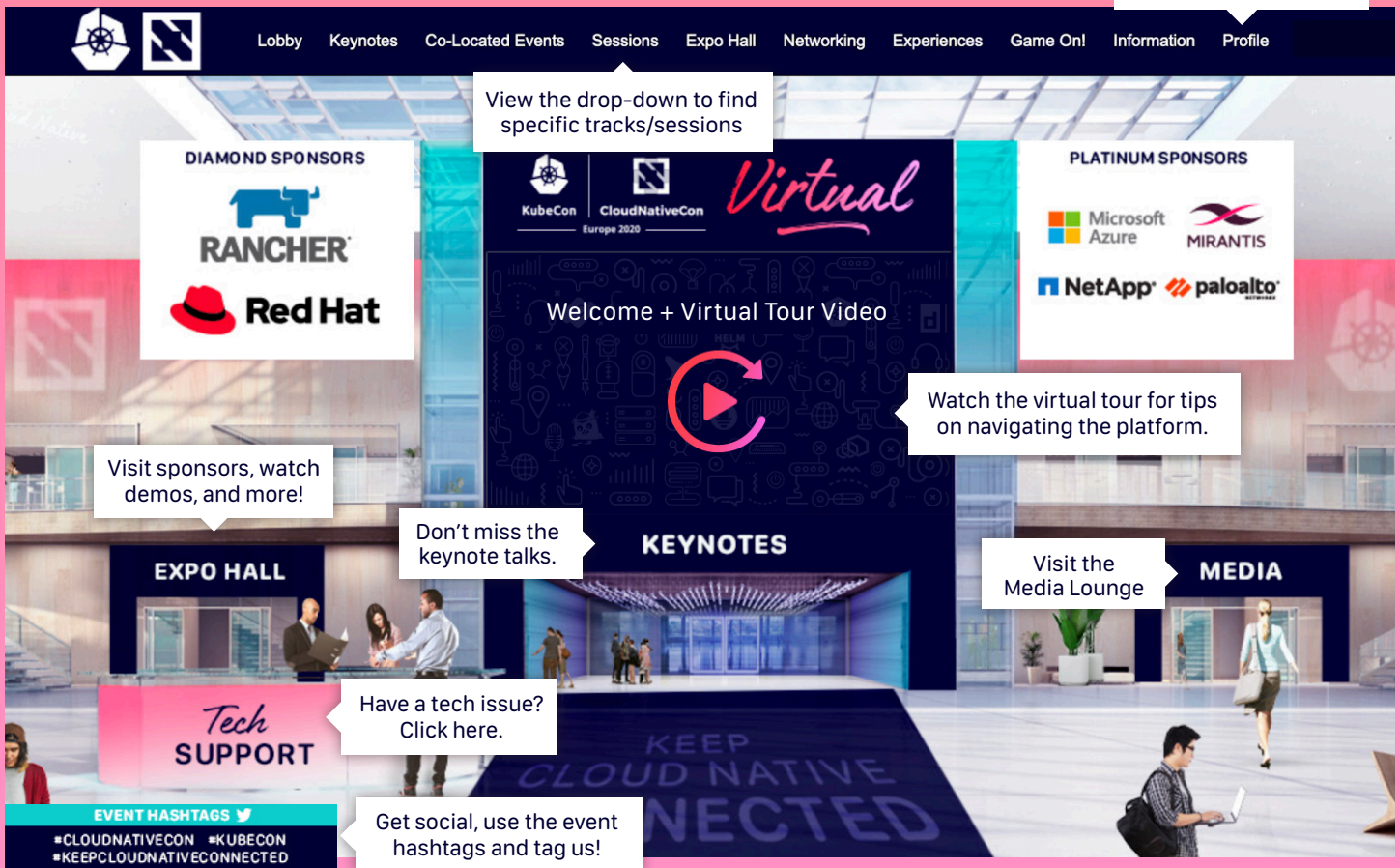
For technical support in the platform, head to the "Tech Support desk" in the lobby or under Information on the top navigation bar. An InXpo representative will be standing by to help.

### EVENT SUPPORT

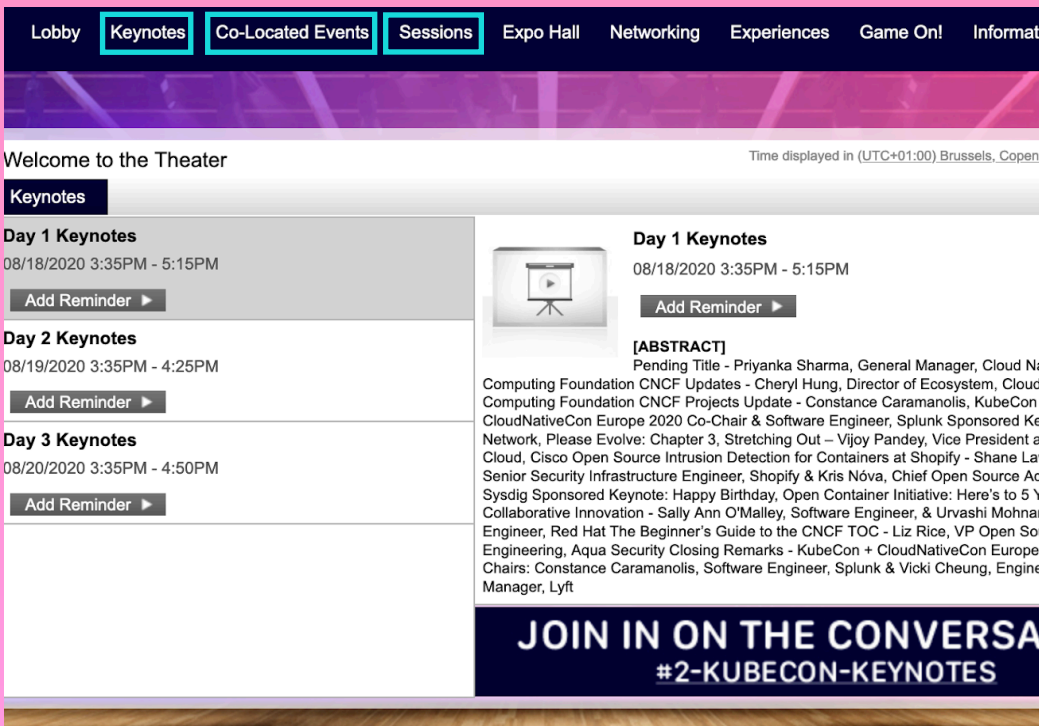

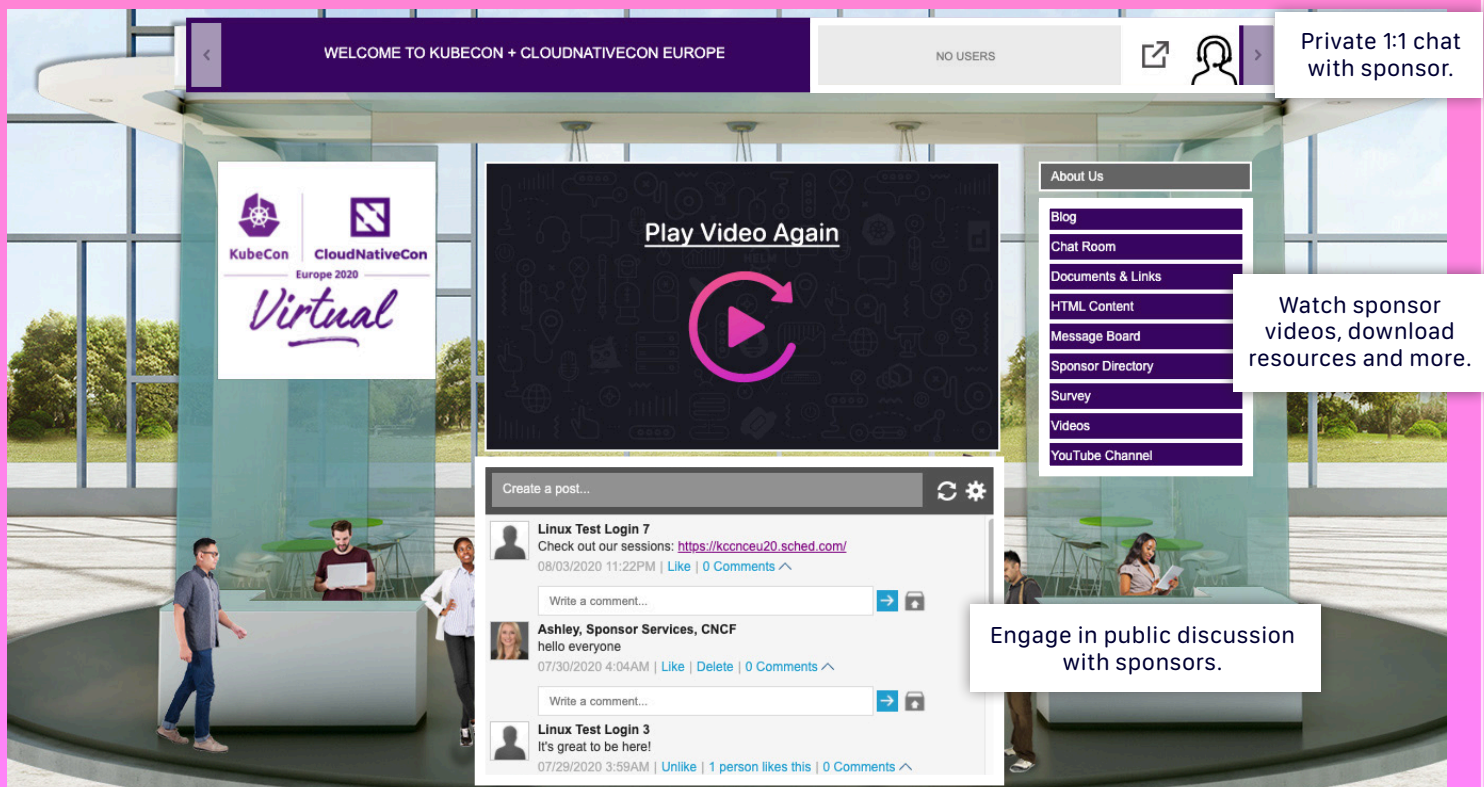
