GET STARTED

- All event participants must abide by our **Code of Conduct**.

ACCESS THE EVENT

- You must be <u>registered</u> to attend KubeCon + CloudNativeCon North America 2021.
- You will need your confirmation number (found in your registration confirmation email) and the same email address you used to register for the event.
- Run a compatibility check*, which tests your webcam and audio devices.
- We are using MeetingPlay, a web-based event platform. You do not need to download any application to participate. MeetingPlay recommends connecting to the event using the Chrome browser from an internet-enabled desktop or laptop.





Keynotes begin at 9:00am PDT, October 13 - 15!








Participate in our many interactive sessions - noting that some activities do require an RSVP.
