Requirements for Participating Projects

Once the project joining is confirmed, the project needs to provide project specific support for SODACODE 2022 and follow the guidelines.

High level expectations are given below. We will provide a detailed guide, templates and tools once the project joining is finalized.

- ▶ Project to provide the SODACODE 2022 interface team (1-3 members per project)
- Need to create specific issues or contribution tasks in your project GitHub (or respective repository)
- All issues need to be added with specific labels for the event, priority, type of tasks etc. We will provide all the needed details on the labels needed
- ▶ Project maintainers need to review the contributions from the SODACODE 2022 participants
- Project interface team to provide the final contribution ranking for the respective projects
- Project needs to be open source with compatible license for public contributions
- ▶ Private repositories under open source projects are *not* allowed
- ▶ All the issues or tasks to be completely open / public
