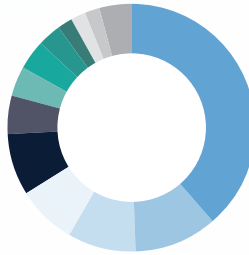
## Open Source Summit & Embedded Linux Conference Demographics

Women and non-binary individuals comprised nearly **a quarter** of attendees



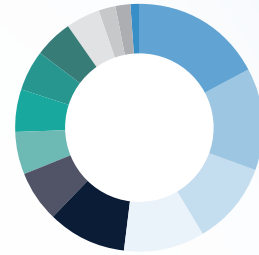

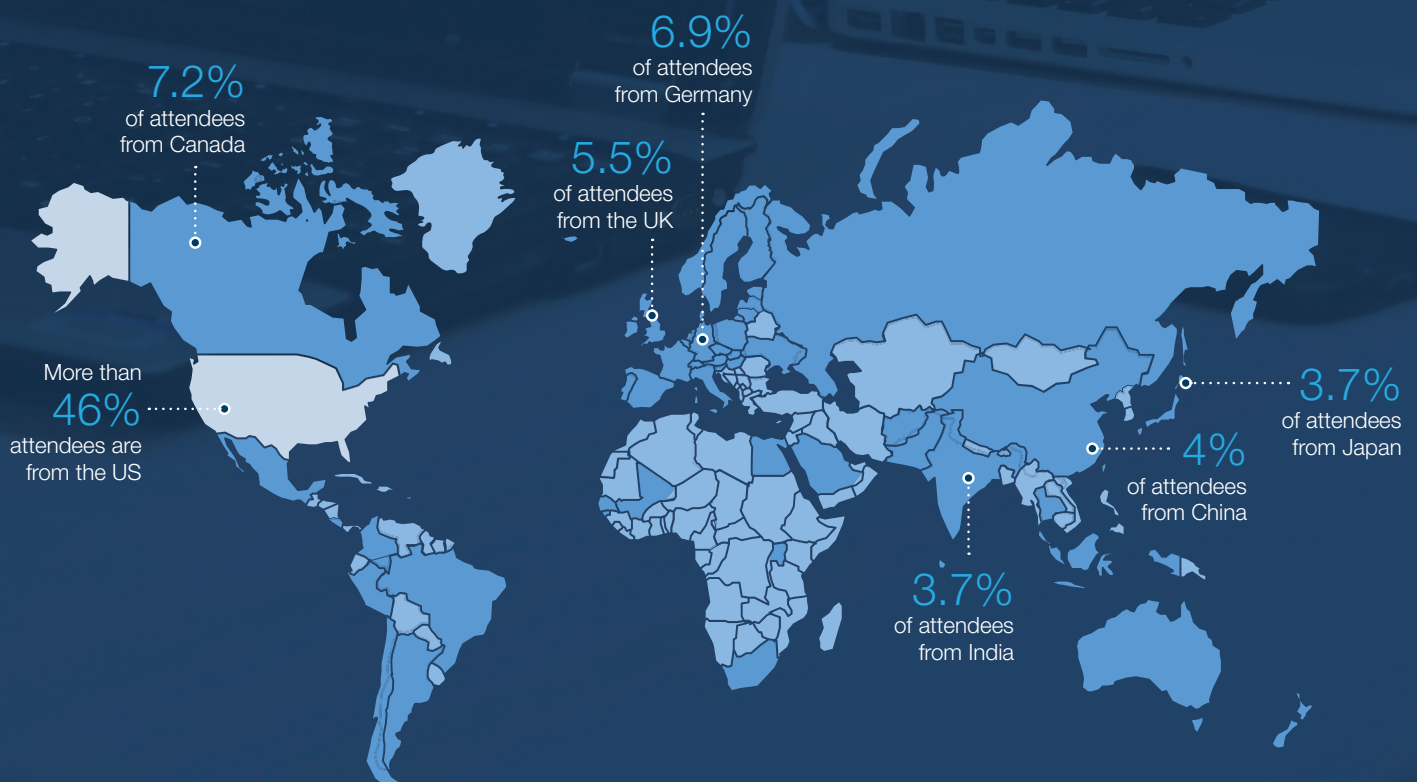

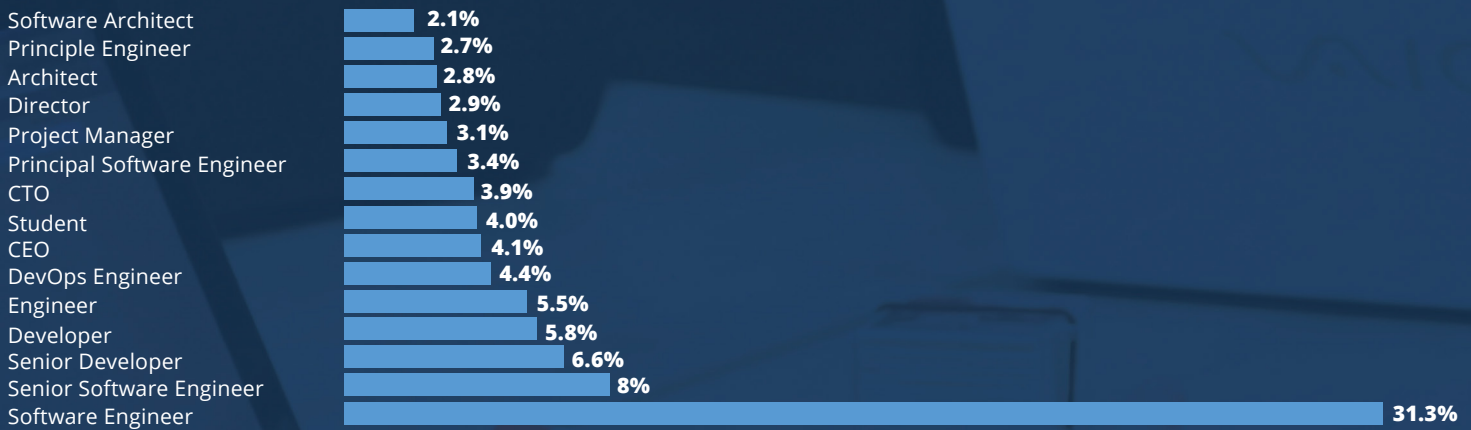

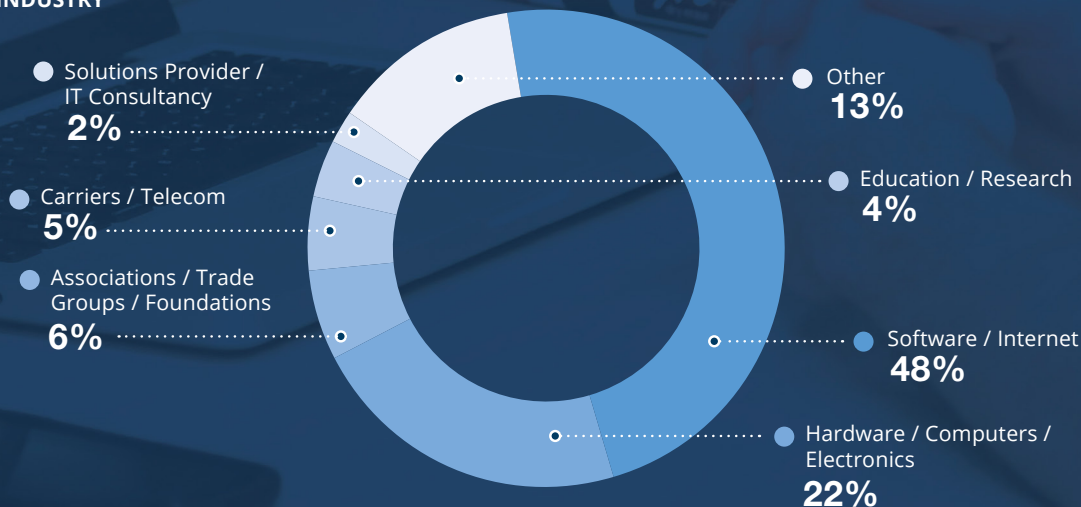
